This Warden Message is to alert U.S. citizens to the recent kidnappings of western tourists in neighboring countries. Although such attacks have not occurred in Algeria against American or other western citizens, terrorists will use any opportunity to target individuals traveling or vacationing in and around Algeria . Per the recent [Algeria Travel Warning](#), terrorist use tactics such as bombings, false roadblocks, kidnappings, ambushes and assassinations regularly. Therefore, make sure to practice sound personal security measures and have a safe and happy holiday season.
