PAGE	REVISION
PAGE 1	The application now indicates that the candidate can upload supplemental documents such as transcripts.
PAGE 1	A note has been added: 'The FLTA Program seeks applicants that have developed a sense of personal integrity and are original thinkers. Applicants that are found to have plagiarized in their application will be disqualified.'
PAGE 2	For # 15 Objectives statement, we are requesting that uploaded essays are limited to a maximum of two pages. Applicants that elect to type their essays in the application are being asked to limit responses to 500 words.
PAGE 3	Under Item #19 is the following text: "LIST EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS ATTENDED IN REVERSE CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER, INCLUDING ANY IN WHICH YOU MAY BE PRESENTLY ENROLLED." 'Please ensure submitted degree names are legible and do not contain symbols. You may submit the translation of the degree name if necessary.'
PAGE 4	For #22 Occupational Experience, preceding the drop-list - The following text is now included: 'If you selected Teacher as occupation, please specify the subject(s) you teach.'
PAGE 4	Item #22: There is now this note: If you are no longer in university and are not employed, please select Other and specify if you are currently seeking employment or applying to graduate school.
PAGE 5	For #26 Language Skills, to ensure candidates include an assesment of their English skills there is a new category column : 'Host Language'
PAGE 6, 7 & 8	Items 29, 30 & 31. Responses are requested to be a maximum of 500 words.
PAGE 9	For # 32: Personal Statement the note now reads: 'Please write a narrative concerning your personal history and long-term goals; it should not be a mere listing of facts, nor should it be a copy of the essay provided in #14 of this application. Please do not insert your actual CV or resume in this section. '
PAGE 10	For the SCAF, Line space for all questions following #36 & #37 has now been increased.
